V. New business

- Brandon Bernier presented an out of cycle proposal for a 1:1 device program for 100 students from the summer bridge program
- Pilot can increase scale after 1 year up to 1200 in first gen or don't have access to tech & expand to entire freshman class
- Goal: essential tech tools in the hands of students who need it the most (ipad kit) to see better retention rates, graduation rates, grades
- Includes technology & information literacy workshop
- Spring semester sign agreements hire interns, initial logistics, procurement
- Summer semester: develop distribution model, connect with SRS students, Build technology workshops, Establish MDM
- Fall semester: distribution days, technology workshops, student support
- Spring semester 2025: student success metrics, cohort programming, pilot evaluation & expansion
- The project is 50% co-sponsored at 50% from division of IT
 - Pilot Program cost:
 - Hardware & mobile connections: \$65000
 - Student internship (4): \$35000
 - Division of IT support: \$35000
 - Total pilot program cost: \$135,000
- Funding:
 - Division of IT: \$67500
 - UTFAB (hardware & mobile connections, student internships): \$67500
- Apple sustainability movement & their 10th generation ipad
- Andrew motioned to take a vote of legitimacy, Grace seconded. Vote of legitimacy passed unanimously.
- Andrew motioned to take a vote of funding, Haleigh seconded. 8 votes yes, 1 vote no. Funding vote passed with majority.
